Monticello Plant Sale Saturday, August 28th

This is the 20th year for holding this event in Monticello. Currently, the park is under water after the Lake Delhi dam break, but it is anticipated that it will be open by late August. Members, please bring daylilies and iris that are bare root, marked with name, size, color, hybridizer (if known), and price. Pictures always help sell plants. Companion plants should be in pots, marked, and priced. If you have small tables, bring them for displaying plants. Bring your own seating and a dish to share for the potluck. Sunscreen is usually a must-have.

Set-up starts at 9:00 am Sale is at 10:00 am-1:00 pm

The potluck and a brief CVIDS meeting will take place after the public sale, usually around 12:45 pm. Awarding of the silent auction bid plants will follow the potluck. Then the plants not chosen by silent bid will be auctioned off. Zora Ronan has arranged for the sale to be advertised throughout Eastern lowa via the Monticello, Anamosa, and Cedar Rapids Gazette papers. It will also be advertised on WMT Gardening Hour.
