Gerald Hobbs will talk to us at the February Meeting about hybridizing. Some of our members are experienced hybridizers, but some of us barely know the basics of the birds and bees where flowers are concerned. Before the meeting you might find an interview that Karol Emmerich did to be a good primer.

In the summer of 2010, Karol Emmerich did a 30minute interview with Prairie Yard and Garden that has been shown on public television in several states. It is about daylilies, the operations at Springwood Gardens, and daylily hybridizing. The interviewer did a great job making sure all the bases and basics were covered. Although it was well past peak in the seedling fields and most of the best things were bloomed out, it is still interesting visually. The first half of the interview covers the basics of daylily selection and care. The part about hybridizing (for beginners) is after the 2-minute break in the middle (which talks about the best time to divide perennials).
