Hello CVIDS members,

Here it is the start of bloom season and time to decide which plants you want to bid on for the fall auction.

As in the past, the minimum bid listed is about half the Eureka average price. If the plant wasn't listed in Eureka, I made up the bid. Actually, this year that was only one plant. This year for the first time, some plants will be sold as single fans. Please note on these plants whether you are bidding for a single or double fan. Here are the rules:

- 1. Make your bids in uneven dollar amounts.
- 2. Send your bids to Jean Hecht, 105 N. Dubuque St., North Liberty IA 52317 by August 10. You can also e-mail bids to me at jhecht@mchsi.com if that's easier. Don't send payment at this time.
- 3. I will notify winners before the Monticello sale as to which cultivars they won.
- 4. The plants will be delivered to the sale in Monticello on August 23 and distributed at that time. If you can't attend the sale, plants will be shipped as needed for an additional charge.
- 5. If you're 'babysitting' a plant it is YOUR responsibility to get that plant to Monticello. All plants available for auction need to be at the sale.
- 6. In case of ties, the earliest postmark wins.
- 7. If you haven't already please let me know how many fans of your plants that you will have available for auction. I'm very pleased to say that I do have this information on most of the cultivars. It will make figuring out winning bids ever so much easier.

I included who was growing the plants in the list so you guys can go and visit those gardens if there is a plant that you want to see. I'm reading reports of late bloom seasons from lots of areas of the country. I don't think this garden is more than a few days behind. Although I'm not a display garden, all of you are more than welcome to come and visit any time.

My own bids will be made before this list is mailed out and given to Kim for safe keeping.

Our Annual CVIDS Fall Plant Sale and Potluck in Monticello, Iowa Is Coming up!

Our fall sale will be held on Saturday, August 23rd (mark your calendar!) from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the gazebo in Riverside Park in Monticello, Iowa. Set-up starts at 9 a.m., with the potluck and dispersal of silent auction plants immediately following the sale. Any silent auction club plants that were not bid on will be auctioned off live then. We hold the potluck around one as that is when the rush of public sales usually subsides. So please bring something good to eat!

Please label all plants with name, color and price, at a minimum. Height and flower size, and time of flowering is also nice to know. Choice items might also include hybridizer's name and year of introduction. Iris and daylilies will be sold as bare-root plants. Please wash the roots well and trim back foliage. We recommend that named varieties be priced from \$5 up; unknown varieties and seedlings for less. Companion plants should be potted if possible, labeled and priced. Please bring your labeled iris, daylilies and companion plants to the park by 9 a.m. so we can have everything nicely laid out by 10 a.m. The sale lasts until 1 p.m.

Please price your plants; the members working at the sale may not be familiar with your varieties and may not know what they are worth. If you need some labels, CVIDS has purchased some rolls of them for club use. Give Gerald a call about acquiring some at (319) 372-4178. If possible, try to bring some pictures of the daylilies or iris you are contributing. Customers always ask, "What does this one look like?" It's really helpful to have some pictures so we can show them, not just tell them. Posters with colored pictures of daylilies and iris would be especially helpful. Bringing along blooms is also good for sales—and for everyone's pleasure. We hope all members will be able to contribute plants, help each other with digging and labeling, and/or help out at the sale itself. We want to have a good variety of clean, fresh, healthy plants for sale! Don't forget to tell your friends and neighbors about this sale. Let's make this our most successful fall sale ever!

<u>Directions to Riverside Park</u>: The park is located on Highway 151 in Monticello, across from the Blue Chip Motel and Restaurant. You can park in the lot in the park or along the roadside in it.
