A key component of this document is the CVIDS Constitution, a draft of which was distributed, together with an ancillary document describing the Responsibilities of Officers and Committee Chairs, to the membership by mail prior to the October meeting. Feedback was requested. At the October meeting, Jonathan reviewed key sections of these documents including expansion of the Board to include several Committee Chairs having voting rights. A few revisions were made. The edited version will be discussed at the November meeting.

Nancy Carlisle passed out a survey for all to read, think about, fill out and return. This will be of great importance to know what members are wanting for future meetings, and what committees are a fit for them.

We adjourned at 3:30 pm.

Our next meeting will be November 10, at the Ox Yoke Inn off Interstate 80.
