From Cedar Rapids/Marion: Take Hwy # 13 north past Coggon 2 miles. Turn right on the curve

onto D-62 (toward Monticello/Prairieburg). Go 6 miles to Linn-Jones Rd. Turn right. Go 2 miles.

Knipper's are on the right at the corner.

From Monticello: From Business Hwy 151, turn left (west) at the stoplight at Hardee's through downtown continuing straight through the next stoplight west out of town on D-62. Go 10 miles to Linn-Jones Rd. Turn left. Go 2 miles to Knipper's at the four corners.

To Null's from Knipper's: Turn left out of driveway and go 2 miles to D-62. Turn right to Monticello. Go down hill into town and take a right at the

second stoplight onto South Main St. Turn left at stoplight onto Hwy 38 south and go out of town past the High School and airport to 190th St. (a big Camp Courageous sign.) Turn left onto 190th St. which is a hard surface road and go 1.7 miles to 122nd Ave. Turn left and follow the gravel road as it curves to the right. Nulls are at the end of the road.

**Pizza Ranch** for lunch. Leave Nulls, turn right onto 190th St. Go 1.7 mi., turn right onto Hwy. 38 and travel back to Monticello. Pizza Ranch is on the right.

Go 1/2 block and turn left onto 5th St. Go about 6 blocks and turn right onto Kelley Ct. Susan's place is the yellow house on the corner. There is parking on the circle court and on 5th St.
