The Betty Miller Memorial Photography Contest

ATTENTION!!!

From the committee members: Kim Edge, Bob Moore and Jan Null......

Dust those cameras off, buy some fresh batteries and film and get busy capturing photos of your favorite daylilies or garden landscapes and enter them in the Betty Miller Memorial Photography Contest. The two categories that will be judged are 'doubles' and 'people's choice. Betty loved daylilies and seemed to be particularly fond of doubles. This contest is open to members of CVIDS. The rules are:

- 1.) Each member can enter a maximum of 5 photos for each category.
- 2.) The photo size must be at least 3"x 5" but can be larger if you wish.
- 3.) Photos must be mailed to Ed Voss at the following address and postmarked by the deadline of September 15, 2006.

- 4.) Do not mark the front or back of the photos in any way EXCEPT to designate in which category you want each photo entered. This means that each photo should ONLY read 'doubles' or 'people's choice' on the back. No other type of identification is allowed. Mr. Voss will mark the back of each photo with a code to identify owner-ship of the submitted photos.
- 5.) For the 'doubles' category, the photo must be of a double daylily(s).
- 6.) For the 'people's choice' category, the photo can be of any daylily(s), for example: single, double, unusual form, etc. or a landscape shot which includes at least 1 daylily.
- 7.) The 'doubles' category winners will be announced at the fall banquet, where all the 'doubles' category entries will be on display. The photographer of the Grand Champion photo will receive \$25. Honorable mention will go to the runner-up photo, but there will be no cash award for honorable mention.
- 8.) The club members will vote on the people's choice award at the banquet. First place will receive \$15 and second place will receive \$10.
- 9.) The photographers will remain anonymous until after the judging.

Remember, the deadline is September 15, 2006 so send those photos in!!!
