● Officer Reports

- President - Heather Harroun: Thanked everyone for attending the fall sale and club plant return today.

● Committee Reports

- Hospitality - Nancy Rash: The Fall Banquet will be held on November 9th at the Radisson Hotel in Coralville. The speaker has been confirmed - Curt Hanson from Ohio. The program will primarily include pictures of seedlings and his goals as a hybridizer - he calls this program "Self Imposed Paradize: Creating a Spiritual Comfort Zone in an Evermore Dystopian World". The Fall Banquet will be attended

by the Region 1 President, Lisa Schmidt. She will ask members to fill out a survey asking why you do or do not attend the summer regional meetings. Last, if people come to your garden, please have CVIDS brochures available to promote the club.
