And we learned that late planted daylilies need to be anchored down with a brick to prevent heaving (from the freeze/thaw cycle).

We also saw some great fencing ideas to keep deer out of the daylily bed complete with aluminum pie tins hung to fly in the wind and create noise and the addition of bags of Lysol to deter deer with the "offensive smell" technique.

It was a great exchange of ideas and information. 36 Members attended.
